## Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Meetings Announcement

The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) announces that several meetings will be held to consider proposed amendments to the **Fiscal Years (FY) 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), Final Congestion Management Process (CMP), Draft 2015 Unified Planning and Work Program (UPWP) , Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) projects** and discuss other business items. The following meetings are scheduled during May 2014:

**Technical Coordinating Committee**—The Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) advises the MPO on the feasibility and technical aspects of proposed transportation projects. The TCC will meet on **Tuesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

**Citizens Advisory Committee**—The Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC), the organized forum for local citizens involved in the transportation planning process, also advises the MPO. The CAC will meet **Tuesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at 2:00 p.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

**Metropolitan Planning Organization**—The Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the policy board of local elected and appointed officials responsible for approving transportation projects and setting transportation policy in the study area portion of the tri-county area, and for the adoption of the required transportation documents for the Montgomery Study Area. The MPO will meet on **Thursday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2014 at 11:30 a.m.** at Prattville Chamber of Commerce located at 131 N Court St., Prattville, AL, 36067.

The proposed amendment transportation projects to be considered at each meeting for the **FY-2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** are as follows:

1. **Project Number: IM-6-AM:** Resurface I-65 from south of SR-3 (US-31) interchange line to 1 mile south of CR-61 overpass. This project is for preliminary engineering. The engineering is a cost of \$150,000 dollars with \$135,000 dollars in federal funds and \$15,000 matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
2. **Project Number: IM-7-AM:** Resurface I-65 from south of SR-3 (US-31) interchange line to 1 mile south of CR-61 overpass. This project is for construction. The construction is a cost of \$1,234,000 dollars with \$1,110,600 dollars in federal funds and \$123,400 matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
3. **Project Number: ATRIP-31-AM:** Resurface Wares Ferry Road (CR-64) from Montgomery City limits east to SR-126 (US-80) at Mt Meigs Rd. This project is for construction. The construction is a total cost of \$1,350,000 dollars with \$1,080,000 in federal funds and \$270,000 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the City of Montgomery. This is an ATRIP project.
4. **Project Number: ATRIP-32-AM:** Service Road improvements along SR-6 (US-231) at H. Council Trenholm State Technical College. This project is for construction. The construction is a total cost of \$1,424,275 dollars with \$1,139,420 in federal funds and \$284,855 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the City of Montgomery. This is an ATRIP project.
5. **Project Number: EC-14-AM:** Corridor Study for Redland Road (CR-8) from US-231 to Rifle Range Road (CR-4). This project is for preliminary engineering. The engineering is a total cost of \$568,976 dollars with \$455,180 in federal funds and \$113,795 in matching funds. This is a cost increase from \$441,869, an increase of \$127,107. The project sponsor is Elmore County Commission.
6. **Project Number: NHS-9-AM:** Access management intersection improvement on along SR-6 (US-231) at H. Council Trenholm State Technical College. This project is for preliminary engineering and construction. The construction is a total cost of \$414,000 dollars with \$331,200 in federal funds and \$82,800 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
7. **Project Number: BR-2-AM:** Bridge culvert replacement on SR-6 (US-82) over Pine Creek BIN#5805. This project is for preliminary engineering. The engineering is a total cost of \$100,000 dollars with \$80,000 in federal funds and \$20,000 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
