At the regularly scheduled meeting of the Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) on March 17, 2015 at 10 a.m. at the City of Montgomery Intermodal Transfer Facility in the conference room, 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, the aforementioned members were present. The meeting was called to order at 10:12 a.m. by Mr. Robert Smith.

Agenda Item 2: Mr. Smith announced that a quorum was present, with 13 voting members present.

Agenda Item 3: Introduction of Guest: Brian Hynniman, John Walker, and Matt Stoops.

Agenda Item 4: Minutes from the previous TCC Meeting. (Action Item)The minutes from the previous TCC Meeting in September, Mr. Bowden made a motion to accept the minutes, and Mr. Miller seconded the motion. The agenda item passed unanimously and without any further discussion.

Agenda Item 5: FY 2012- 2015 TIP Amendments: Mr. Smith discussed each project.

- Page 2: State of Alabama project for resurfacing I-85 from just east of Ann Street (Exit 3) to just west of SR-8 (US-80) Eastern Blvd (Exit 6); a distance of 2.80 miles. The funding source Interstate Maintenance (IM) Funds. The federal match will cover \$6,814,080 and local match \$757,120 total cost \$7,571,200.(This project has increase of \$7,360,000 federal and local match 1,840,000 total cost \$9,200,000)
- Page 3: Is An Roadside hardware assessment pilot program for Autauga, Lowndes, and Montgomery and Butler counties. The funding source will be Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Funds. (Special Project). The federal match will cover \$418,771 and no local match funds, total cost \$418,771.
- Page 4: Is an Elmore County Commission project for Intersection study at the Intersection of Coosada Parkway and Coosada Road. The funding source Surface Transportation Program Other Area (STPOA) Funds. The federal match will cover \$124,800 and local match \$31,200 total cost \$156,000. (This project is proposed to be deleted and funds moved to the next following project.)
- Page 5: Is an Elmore County Commission project for Bridge Replacement at Ingram Road at Cotton Ford Creek (BIN#7874), the funding source Surface Transportation Program Other Area (STPOA) Funds. The federal match funds will cover \$2,124,675 and local match \$531,169 total cost \$2,655,844. (This project is for a cost increase due to increased construction costs, the amount of increase is \$1,134,324 of which \$907,459 is federal and \$226,864 is local match.)
- Page 6: Is an Elmore County Commission project for Bridge replacement at Mehearg Road over Callaway Creek (BIN#7575). The funding source Surface Transportation Program Other Area (STPOA) Funds. The federal match will cover \$1,061,794 and local match \$265,449 total cost \$1,327,243. (This project is for a cost increase due to increased construction costs, the amount of increase is \$391,043 of which \$312,834 is federal and \$78,209 is local match.)
- Page 7: Is an Elmore County Commission project for Bridge replacement at Coosada Parkway at Coosada Creek. The funding source Surface Transportation Program Other Area (STPOA) Funds. The federal match will cover \$761,406 and local match \$190,351 total cost \$951,757. (This project is for a cost decrease based on the DOT engineers estimate, the amount of decrease is \$403,243 of which \$322,594 is federal and \$80,648 is local.)
- Page 8: Is a City of Wetumpka project for Resurfacing only Court Street, East Bridge from S Main Street to Hill Street, resurface sidewalks improvements, landscaping and pedestrian lighting fixtures on Company Street from Hill Street to Orline St, Orline Street from Company Street to Hill Street and on Hill Street from Orline St to Company. A distance of 1.12 miles, funding source Surface Transportation Program Other Area

(STPOA) Funds. The federal match will cover \$65,928 and local match \$16,483 total cost \$82,411. (This project is for a cost increase due to change in scope of work from \$25,431 to \$82,411 the amount of increase is \$56,980 of which \$45,584 is federal and \$11,396 is local match.)

- Page 9: Is a City of Wetumpka project for Utility relocation, street improvements, and Resurfacing and sidewalks improvements on Company Street from Logan Street to E Bridge Street then E Bridge Street to S Main Street and S Main Street to US 231. A distance of 1.12 miles, the funding source Surface Transportation Program Other Area (STPOA) Funds. The federal fund match will cover \$65,928 and local match \$16,483 total cost \$84,411. (This project is for a cost increase from \$4,000 (state support services) to \$84,411 for real engineering costs estimate.)
- Page 10:Is an State of Alabama project for Montgomery County Bridge replacement on US-231 at Jenkins Creek (NB RDWY) Bin#000735 STR #6-51-17.5; a distance of .01 miles. The funding source State Bridge (BR) Funds. The federal match will cover \$164,455 and local match \$41,113 total cost \$205,569.

After discussing all the projects, a motion was made by Mr. Beyer and seconded by Mr. Duke; therefore the agenda item passed unanimously and without any further discussion.

Agenda Item 6 : FY 2015 Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) receives a direct annual allocation for the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for \$415,413. With the FY2015 allocation, the Montgomery MPO Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) has a balance of \$753,362 (Federal funds only). Five applications were received from the following municipalities: City of Prattville, the Town of Pike Road, and the City of Wetumpka. A motion was made to fully fund 3 projects and partially fund 1, Mr. Beyer made the motion, and Mr. Robison seconded. Therefore, the agenda item passed unanimously and without any further discussion.

Agenda Item 7: 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)Update: The objective of this report is to provide socioeconomic projections to the year 2040 for the counties in the Montgomery, Alabama Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). These forecasts will be used to inform the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) update for the MPO. All forecasts are calculated in five-year intervals from 2015 through 2040 for each of the counties and for the MPO as a whole.

- Old Farm Lane (Prattville) has been completed.
