Perry Street is a very important street in the Garden District . The street should be converted to a 2 way street with parking added with greenery added to some offset parking . All the hex pavers on the Sidewalk should be kept and reset, the granite curbs have to be kept , handicap accessibility should be added and the street should be made pedestrian friendly. Federal funds are being used and the neighborhood is very concerned about the project. The one lane north and one lane south would slow down traffic and deter crime. The Alabama Governor's mansion is on Perry Street and this street is important to the entire state.

Fairview avenue is very important to the Garden District. This street should be narrowed with one lane in each direction , parking added as it was taken away with the so called Urban Renewal years ago - and the beautiful homes lost their street parking, a roundabout should be put in at the 5 points where Cloverdale Rd, Fairview, and Woodley intersect, greenery should be added, handicap accessibility should be added, a sidewalk should be added and this street should be made pedestrian friendly . Dear Mr. Lee:

I am writing this letter in opposition to the proposed ALDOT Project involving Fairview Avenue from South Court Street to Cloverdale Road. As you know, the area west of Norman Bridge Road is initially residential but then rapidly turns commercial as one approaches Court Street which is very near being commercial. In addition, there is quite a bit of foot and automobile traffic from Lanier High School traveling south on Court Street and across Fairview Avenue. That condition may possibly justify widening the street in that area.

Conversely, the area east of Norman Bridge Road to Cloverdale Road is entirely residential and at least two blocks from any commercial establishments (i.e., the Five Points area). It is a quiet neighborhood and certainly not in need of additional street widening and/or sidewalks.

The disruption proposed by the proposed project as well as sidewalks would only create a disturbance for a substantial amount of time. It cannot benefit the Cloverdale/Cloverdale Idlewild historic district in any manner.


In addition, sidewalks would invite foot traffic from the Five Points bars. There are already too many people wondering around the Bottom Park and Cloverdale Road, and sleeping in the Bottom Park gazebo, etc. in the early morning hours as a result of drinking at the bars. I believe sidewalks would only encourage such persons to frequent the Cloverdale Idlewild/Cloverdale neighborhood.
