At the regularly scheduled meeting of the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) on March 10, 2016 at 10 a.m. at the City of Montgomery Intermodal Transfer Facility in the conference room, 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, the aforementioned members were present. The meeting was called to order at 10:08 a.m. by Mr. Robert Smith.

Agenda Item 2: Mr. Smith announced that a quorum was present, with 12 voting members present.

Agenda Item 3: Introduction of Guest: Mr. Matt Stopps with Sain Associates,

Agenda Item 4: Minutes from the previous TAC Meeting, (Action Item): There were no corrections or revisions to the minutes, a motion was made by Mr. Beyer to adopt the minutes, and seconded by Mr. Duke; therefore the agenda item passed unanimously and without any further discussion.

Agenda Item 5: FY 2016-2019 (TIP) Amendments:

- Page 2: City of Montgomery project for widening, leveling, resurfacing and traffic striping on Ann Street from Highland Avenue to Brewton Street; a distance of .45 miles. The funding source will be Surface Transportation Montgomery (STPMN) Funds. (This project is proposed to be reduced from \$1,169,859 to \$ 919,859 (a reduction of \$250,000) and those funds reallocated to the following project.
- Page 3: A City of Montgomery project for ADA Transition Study, the funding source Surface Transportation Montgomery (STPMN) Funds. The federal match will cover \$200,000 and local match \$50,000 total cost \$250,000.
- Page 4: State of Alabama project for Installation of a roundabout at the intersection of Oak Street and Edgemont Avenue in the City of Montgomery. The funding source will be Highway Safety Improvement (HSIP) Funds 90% of the match will be federal, and 10% will be local match. (The PE cost will be 45,000 and local match 5,000.00 totals cost \$50,000; the CN cost \$409,050 and local match \$45,450 total cost \$454,500.)
- Page 5: Autauga County Commission project; for Autauga County Rural Transit. Section 5311 Transit Autauga County Commission Capital Non- Vehicle FY 2016. (VEHICLE PURCHASE) The federal match will cover \$8,000 and local match \$2,000 total cost \$10,000.

After discussing the TIP Amendment projects, a motion was made by Mr. Beyer and seconded by Mr. Duke; therefore the agenda item passed unanimously and without any further discussion.

Agenda Item 6: Transportation Project Status (ALDOT) (David Bollie)

- SR-126 Resurfacing and Safety Widening from Atlanta Highway to Chantilly Parkway
- I-85 Resurfacing from Hall Street to North of Ann Street is scheduled to be complete in June 2016.
- The Service Road Improvements along SR-6 (US-82/US-231) near Trenholm State College will begin in April.
- I-65 resurfacing from South of US-31 Interchange (MP 186) to CR-61 (MP 19), scheduled to begin in April.
- I-65 resurfacing from Elmore County Line (MP 181.5) to South of US-31 (MP 186), scheduled to begin in April.
- Resurfacing of US-82 (Troy Hwy) from the Eastern Bypass to Taylor Road, scheduled to begin in May.
- Resurfacing of I-85 from East of Ann Street to West of SR-8 (US-80) Eastern Boulevard, scheduled to begin in May.
- The Montgomery Outer Loop (Lighting), will be let at the end of April.
- The Chantilly Pkwy Access Management from West of Technacenter Drive to Eastchase Parkway should be complete by April.
