At the regularly scheduled meeting of the Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) on November 16, 2017 at 11:30 a.m. at the Montgomery Intermodal Conference Room 495 Molton Street Montgomery, Alabama, the aforementioned members were present.

Agenda Item 2: A quorum assessment, with 9 voting members present; and 5 Proxy. The MPO Meeting began 11:38 am.

Agenda Item 3: Introduction of Guests: Mr. Bryan Fair and Mr. Michael Hora of ALDOT Central and Commissioner Isaiah Sankey (Montgomery County)

Agenda Item 4: Minutes from the previous MPO Meeting (Action) The Minutes from the previous MPO Meeting a motion was made by Mr. Bollinger and seconded by Mr. Willis to adopt the minutes from the previous MPO. Therefore, the agenda item passed unanimously and without any further discussion.

Agenda Item 5: FY 2016-2019 TIP Amendment (Action Item) (Mr. Anderson provided the update)

Page 2: A State of Alabama project for Intersection Improvements at Exit 9 (Taylor Road) (SR-271) onto I-85 Southbound. The funding source will be Surface Transportation Program Any Area (STPAA) Funds. The federal match for PE work \$121,200 and local match \$30,300 total cost \$151,500. The CN work federal match \$2,020,00 and local match \$505,000 total cost \$2,525,00.

Page 3: A State of Alabama project for Bridge Culvert Replacement on SR-6 (US-82) (Prattville Bypass) over Pine Creek Bin #5805. The funding source Bridge (BR) Funds. The federal fund match will cover \$440,000 and local match \$110,000 and total cost \$550,000.

Page 4: A State of Alabama project for Additional Lanes on SR-110 from Chantilly Pkwy to the Outer Loop. A distance of 4.2 miles; the funding source will be Surface Transportation Program Any Area (STPAA) Funds. The federal fund will cover \$686,800 and local match \$171,700 and total cost \$858,500. (**This project is being moved from FY 2021 to FY 2019.**)

Page 5: The City of Montgomery is moving the Downtown Street Light Conversion to LED Project # 100063693 (not shown) to FY 2020 and replacing them with following two projects. This project is for Widening and Resurfacing Perry Hill Road from Harrison Road to 3 Mile Creek; a distance of 1 mile. The federal fund match will cover \$1,052,000 and local match \$263,000 total cost \$1,315,000.

Page 6: The City of Montgomery project for Intersection Improvement at the Intersection of Perry Hill Road and Atlanta Highway. The funding source will be Surface Transportation Program Montgomery (STPMN) Funds. The federal match fund will cover \$444,000 and local match \$111,000 total cost \$555,000.

Page 7: An Elmore County Commission project for Installing Micro-surfacing pavement and Traffic Stripe Redland Road from Rifle Range Road east to Marshell Road; a distance of 7.4 miles. The funding source Surface Transportation Program Montgomery (STPMN) Funds. The PE work federal funds \$4,000 and local match \$1,000 total cost \$5,000. The CN work federal fund match will cover \$276,000 and local match \$69,000 total cost \$345,000.

Page 8: An Elmore County Commission project for Install Micro-surfacing pavement and Traffic Stripe Firetower Road from Redland Road north to SR-14. A distance of 3.9 miles. The funding source will be Surface Transportation Program Montgomery (STPMN) Funds. The PE work federal match funds \$4,000 and local match \$1,000 total cost \$5,000. The CN work federal funds will cover \$142,000 and local match \$35,700 and total cost \$178,800.

After discussing the TIP Amendment projects, and all are in balance with an increase of \$250,000

After reviewing and discussing all projects; all are in balance and on schedule; a motion was made by Mr. Bollinger and seconded by Mr. Dean; Therefore, the agenda item passed unanimously and without any further discussion.

Agenda Item 6: Final 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) Amendment (Action)

The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) adopted the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan September 17, 2015. Federal Law requires the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to jointly certify the transportation planning processes of Transportation Management Areas (TMAS) at least every four years. In early 2016, the Montgomery MPO had its first Certification Review since gaining the TMA designation in the 2010 US Census. The 14 day comment period being done.

A motion to adopt the Draft for the LRTP was made by Mr.Dean; and seconded by Mr. Bollinger. Therefore the agenda item passed unanimously and without any further discussion.

- **Montgomery County**: MOL lighting project (Montgomery Outer Loop) Work has begun, scheduled to be complete February 2018.
- Montgomery County: Traffic & Pedestrian improvements on Ann Street at I-85; Punch list items being done
- Elmore County: Intersection improvements and bridge replacement on SR-14 @ SR-143; Phase I of CSX bridge complete, working on Phase II of CSX bridge, estimated completion date June 2018.
- **Autauga County:** Bridge replacement on SR-14 over Beaver & Ivy Creeks, scheduled to be complete June 2018.
- **Montgomery County:** Resurface Eastern Bypass from Troy Highway to I-85; Permanent striping remaining.
- Elmore County: Resurface SR-14 from east of I-65 to just west of SR-143; Accepted for maintenance.
- **Autauga County:** Resurface SR-14 from east city limits of Autaugaville to SR-6 (US-82); waiting on final inspection.
- **Montgomery County:** Resurface I-65 from Pintala Creek Relief to north of Pintala Creek; Permanent striping remaining.
- Autauga County: Resurface SR-6 (US-82) from SR-14 to SR-3 (US-31) accepted for maintenance
- **Montgomery County:** Resurface I-85 from end of 6-lane at Taylor Road to the Macon County Line.

Agenda Item 9: Any Other Issues/Business/ Concerns: One concern regarding the closed road on Norman Bridge Road (Bridge) near Hyundai Boulevard.
