- Congestion Management Plan and Public Participation Plan will be updated in FY 2021.
- Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5303 Planning Funds have been combined with Federal Highway Administration Funds to be one (1) fund for better management.
- Funds pay for 5 –fulltime staff person's salaries, planning and programming work related to required documents, MPO administration and other federal requirements, general operating costs for meetings, advertising for meetings, public hearings and various other activities.

- Fiscal Years 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) will be amended as needed.
- Various other transportation planning duties such as, prior year authorized projects list report and advertisement, overall GIS database update and maintenance and other associated GIS work related to planning and programming activities, traffic count updates, report writing, grant writing, etc.

After the summary highlights were done, Mr. Miller made the motion to adopt the Final Draft for the 2021 Unified Planning and Work Program (UPWP); and seconded made by Mr. Beyer. Therefore the agenda item passed unanimously and without any further discussion.
