

Recommendation from the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) for the Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Fiscal Year 2022 Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP)

The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) receives a direct annual allocation for the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP). With the FY 2020 allocation, the Montgomery MPO Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) has a balance of \$2,386,999 (Federal funds only).

Three TAP applications were received from the following municipalities: City of Montgomery and City of Prattville. Below is a summary of each project.
