## TECHNICAL SUMMARY FOR TRANSPORTATION PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT PROPOSED FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) GRANT PROJECTS FOR THE CITY OF MONTGOMERY AND MONTGOMERY AREA TRANSIT SYSTEM (MATS) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009

**1. Summary-** The City of Montgomery and Montgomery Area Transit System (MATS) has multiple grant proposals for the fiscal year (FY) 2009. The grants are as follows: Montgomery Area Transit System Capital and Operating Formula Grant, FY-2009 City of Montgomery Congressional Earmark for the City of Montgomery-Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) Acquisition and Implementation project, FY-2009 Montgomery Area Transit System Economic Stimulus projects, and FY-2007 thru FY-2009 Airport Intermodal project.

The estimated total cost for the Montgomery Area Transit System fiscal year 2009 capital and operating grant is \$4,896,208 of which \$2,660,729 dollars being federal funds and \$2,235,479 being City of Montgomery matching funds. The FY-09 City of Montgomery Congressional Earmark for the City of Montgomery – Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) Acquisition and Implementation project is for \$1,371,250 total dollars of which \$1,097,000 dollars is federal funds and \$274,250 being City of Montgomery matching funds. The FY-09 Montgomery Area Transit System Economic Stimulus project is for \$3,526,918 total dollars of which \$3,526,918 dollars is federal funds and \$0 being City of Montgomery matching funds. The FY-07 thru FY-09 Montgomery Regional Airport Intermodal Improvement project is for \$3,855,000 total dollars of which \$3,084,000 dollars is federal funds and \$771,000 being Montgomery Regional Airport matching funds.
