PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT MEETING AND COMMENT PERIOD ON YEAR 2030 LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN AMENDMENT

Notice is hereby given that the Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). Transportation Planning Staff will hold a Public Involvement Meeting and comment period concerning an amendment to the year 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) has proposed to construct an interchange on I-85 at Wares Ferry Road in Montgomery County, Alabama. The purpose of this new interchange is to provide a new access point to serve existing traffic and future traffic generated in the area from existing and future residential, commercial and industrial development.

The Montgomery MPO is proposing to amend the 2030 LRTP's financially constrained program of projects by adding the proposed new interchange into the LRTP, and also amend the regional travel demand model so that the project is included. The estimated total cost of the project is \$40.085,306 total dollars in Federal and ALDOT matching funds for preliminary engineering, right of way, utility relation and construction costs. The following meeting is scheduled for March 30, 2009:

Metropolitan Planning Organization—The Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the body of local elected officials responsible for approving transportation projects and setting overall transportation policy in the study area portion of the tri-county area, and for adoption of the required transportation documents for the Montgomery Study Area. The Public Involvement Meeting will be held on Monday, March 30, 2009 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the City of Montgomery-City Council Chambers, City of Montgomery City Hall, located at 103 North Perry Street, Montgomery, AL 36104. The Public Involvement Meeting format will be an open house format for the meeting. Attendance at the meeting is at the general public's convenience. Preliminary maps and other information concerning the proposed new interchange project and 2030 LRTP amendment will be available at the meeting as well as at public involvement sites listed below. Representatives from the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Planning Staff will be available to answer questions during the meeting.
