Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Transportation Meetings Announcement

The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) announces that several meetings will be held to consider proposed amendments to the **Fiscal Years (FY) 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** document, to review and approve the **Draft Fiscal Year 2012 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)**, to consider the proposed projects for the **Fiscal Years (FY) 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** document, and to review the **Proposed Draft Fiscal Years (FY) 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** document (if available).

The following meetings are scheduled during July, 2011:

Technical Coordinating Committee—The Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) advises the MPO on the feasibility and technical aspects of proposed transportation projects. The TCC will meet on Tuesday, July 19th, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. at the City of Montgomery Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Citizens Advisory Committee—The Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC), the organized forum for local citizens involved in the transportation planning process, also advises the MPO. The CAC will meet on Tuesday, July 19th, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. at the City of Montgomery Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Metropolitan Planning Organization—The Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the body of local elected officials responsible for approving transportation projects and setting transportation policy in the study area portion of the tri-county area, and for adoption of the required transportation documents for the Montgomery Study Area. The MPO will meet on Thursday, July 21st, 2011 at 2:00p.m at the City of Montgomery Intermodal Transportation Facility located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

The proposed amendment transportation projects to be considered at each meeting for the **FY-2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** are as follows:

1. **Project Number E-19-AM:** Level and Stripe CR-8 (Redland Rd) from CR-116 (Marshall Rd) to CR-73. The project scope is for construction for a total cost of \$906,360 total dollars with \$725,088 in federal funds and \$181,272 in matching funds. The project length is 6.29 miles. The project sponsor is the Elmore County Commission.
2. **Project Number E-20-AM:** Pavement preservation on SR-111 from 1 mile north of CR-366 (Crenshaw Rd.) to SR-143. The project scope is for FM for a total cost of \$981,115 total dollars with \$784,892 in federal funds and \$196,115 in matching funds. The project length is 12.0 miles. The project sponsor is the Elmore County Commission.
3. **Project Number M-55-AM:** Widen & Resurface Ann Street from Brewton Street and realign Federal Drive (Phase 1). This project is a price increase. The project scope is for preliminary engineering for a total cost of \$358,007 total dollars with \$286,406 in federal funds and \$71,601 in matching funds. The project length is 0.22 miles. The project sponsor is the City of Montgomery.
4. **Project Number M-56-AM:** Widen Perry Hill Road to five lanes from I-85 on/off ramp to Harrison Road. This project is a price increase. The total price increase is \$650,000. The project scope is for construction for a total cost of \$2,984,135 total dollars with \$2,854,135 in federal funds and \$130,000 in matching funds. The project length is 0.49 miles. The project sponsor is the City of Montgomery.
5. **Project Number M-57-AM:** Resurface Madison Avenue from Coosa Street to North Ripley Street. This project is a price increase. The total price increase is \$300,000. The project scope is for construction for a total cost of \$3,150,260 total dollars with \$3,070,260 in federal funds and \$60,000 in matching funds. The project length is 0.67 miles. The project sponsor is the City of Montgomery.

Final Fiscal Year 2012 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) is as follows:

This document includes the annual work tasks that the Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Staff undertakes during a given fiscal year, such as updating and maintaining transportation plans, programs and projects throughout the three county transportation study area. The total budget proposed is \$437,898 of which 80%, \$350,318, is federal, and 20%, \$87,580, is City of Montgomery local match. The MPO will consider this document as a draft and undergo a two week public involvement period and the final document will be considered in August or September 2011.

The Proposed Draft **Fiscal Years (FY) 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** document will presented to the committees for review, if available.
