- 1. **Transportation Public Involvement Summary**-The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) announces that the FY 08-11 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is available for public review and comment. This is the FY-2010 Annual Rebalance/Update of the four year document that shows annual financial constraint. The FY 08-11 TIP is the list of transportation projects for the three county transportation study area. The draft TIP document has an estimated \$305,805,773 total dollars planned and programmed for years 2008-2011. The TIP's companion plans, as required by the United States Department of Transportation, are the 1-year *Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)* and the 20-25 Year *Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)*.
- 2. **Background**-Each of the 13 urban areas in Alabama are required to have a transportation planning process in order to receive Federal Highway and Transit Capital or Operating Assistance funding. The TIP is a four year program of planned improvements for roads, bridges and transit services projectd in the MPO transportation study area. The Montgomery transportation study area receives about \$4.1 million per year in sub-allocated funding based on its urbanized area population of 196,892. The State of Alabama also selects discretionary projects to be constructed in the Montgomery transportation study area as well.
