

Technical Summary for the Year 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan Amendment Number Two (2)

1. **Transportation Public Involvement Summary**-The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Planning Staff announces that amendment number two (2) to the year 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) is available for public review and comment. The LRTP is a long range transportation plan document for the three county transportation study area. The LRTP's companion plan's, as required by the United States Department of Transportation, are the short range Congestion Management System Plan (CMSP) and short range Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) documents.

2. **Background**-Each of the 13 urban areas in Alabama are required to have a transportation planning process in order to receive Federal Highway funds and Transit Capital or Operating Assistance funds. The LRTP is a comprehensive master transportation plan that addresses transportation needs over a 20-25 year period. MPOs must have an approved LRTP in order to receive Federal Transportation funds to implement planned projects. The current 2030 LRTP contains \$809 million in planned transportation improvements.
