Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Meetings Announcement

The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) announces that several meetings will be held to consider proposed amendments to the **Fiscal Years (FY) 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), Final 2015 Unified Planning and Work Program (UPWP), FTA request for MPO Resolution for the M Transit** and discuss other business items. The following meetings are scheduled during July 2014:

Technical Coordinating Committee—The Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) advises the MPO on the feasibility and technical aspects of proposed transportation projects. The TCC will meet on **Tuesday, July 15th, 2014 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Citizens Advisory Committee—The Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC), the organized forum for local citizens involved in the transportation planning process, also advises the MPO. The CAC will meet **Tuesday, July 15th, 2014 at 2:00 p.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Metropolitan Planning Organization—The Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the policy board of local elected and appointed officials responsible for approving transportation projects and setting transportation policy in the study area portion of the tri-county area, and for the adoption of the required transportation documents for the Montgomery Study Area. The MPO will meet on **Thursday, July 17th, 2014 at 11:30 a.m.** at the Montgomery Area Transit System Intermodal Facility Conference room located at 495 Molton St, Montgomery, AL 36104.

The proposed amendment transportation projects to be considered at each meeting for the **FY-2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** are as follows:

1. **Project Number: IM-7-AM:** Pavement preservation on I-85 from west of the East Blvd Bypass (US-80) to end of six lane east of Taylor Road. This project is for construction. The construction is a cost of \$9,880,000 dollars with \$8,892,000 dollars in federal funds and \$988,000 matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
2. **Project Number: IM-8-AM:** Resurface I-65 from Pintlala Creek Relief 1 to north Pintlala Creek. This project is for construction. The construction is a cost of \$1,300,000 dollars with \$1,170,000 dollars in federal funds and \$130,000 matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
3. **Project Number: IM-9-AM:** Guide rail installation on I-85 from Ann Street to SR-271 (Taylor Rd). This project is for preliminary engineering and construction. Both phases are a total cost of \$93,000 dollars with \$83,700 in federal funds and \$9,300 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
4. **Project Number: IM-10-AM:** Slope repair on I-65 along southbound outside shoulder just north of SR-3 (US-31) (Exit 186). This project is for preliminary engineering and construction. Both phases are a total cost of \$517,000 dollars with \$413,600 in federal funds and \$103,400 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
5. **Project Number: ST-31-AM:** Cypress Creek Stream and wetland mitigation bank in the City of Montgomery. This project is for construction. The construction is a total cost of \$1,100,000 dollars with \$880,000 in federal funds and \$220,000 in matching funds. The project sponsor is State of Alabama.
6. **Project Number: M-31-AM:** Construction of an 11 ft. wide foot path along Maxwell Blvd between the Intermodal Transfer facility Parking Deck and Wright Brothers Park.. This project is for construction. The construction is a total cost of \$823,826 dollars with \$603,250 in federal funds and \$220,576 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the City of Montgomery.
7. **Project Number: MC-3-AM:** Design Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities on Vaughn Road from Taylor Road to Chantilly Parkway. This project is for preliminary engineering. The engineering is a total cost of \$300,000 dollars with \$240,000 in federal funds and \$60,000 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the City of Montgomery/Montgomery County.
8. **Project Number: TAP-1-AM:** Multi-Purpose Nature Trail on Wallahatchie Road in the Town of Pike Road. This project is for construction. The construction is a total cost of \$125,711 dollars with \$100,569 in federal funds and \$25,142 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the Town of Pike Road.
9. **Project Number: TAP-2-AM:** Pedestrian walkway at Cooters Pond at the Alabama River in the City of Prattville. This project is for construction. The construction is a total cost of \$243,360 dollars with \$194,688 in federal funds and \$48,672 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the City of Prattville.
10. **Project Number: TAP-3-AM:** New sidewalks curb ramps, crosswalks and shared lane bike markings on Oak St. This project is for construction. The construction is a total cost of \$207,318 dollars with \$165,855 in federal funds and \$41,463 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the City of Montgomery.
11. **Project Number: TAP-4-AM:** New sidewalks curb ramps, crosswalks and shared lane bike markings, and the installation of three (3) transit bus shelters near Oak St along the Selma to Montgomery Trail. This project is for preliminary

engineering. The engineering is a total cost of \$120,558 dollars with \$96,447 in federal funds and \$24,111 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the City of Montgomery.
