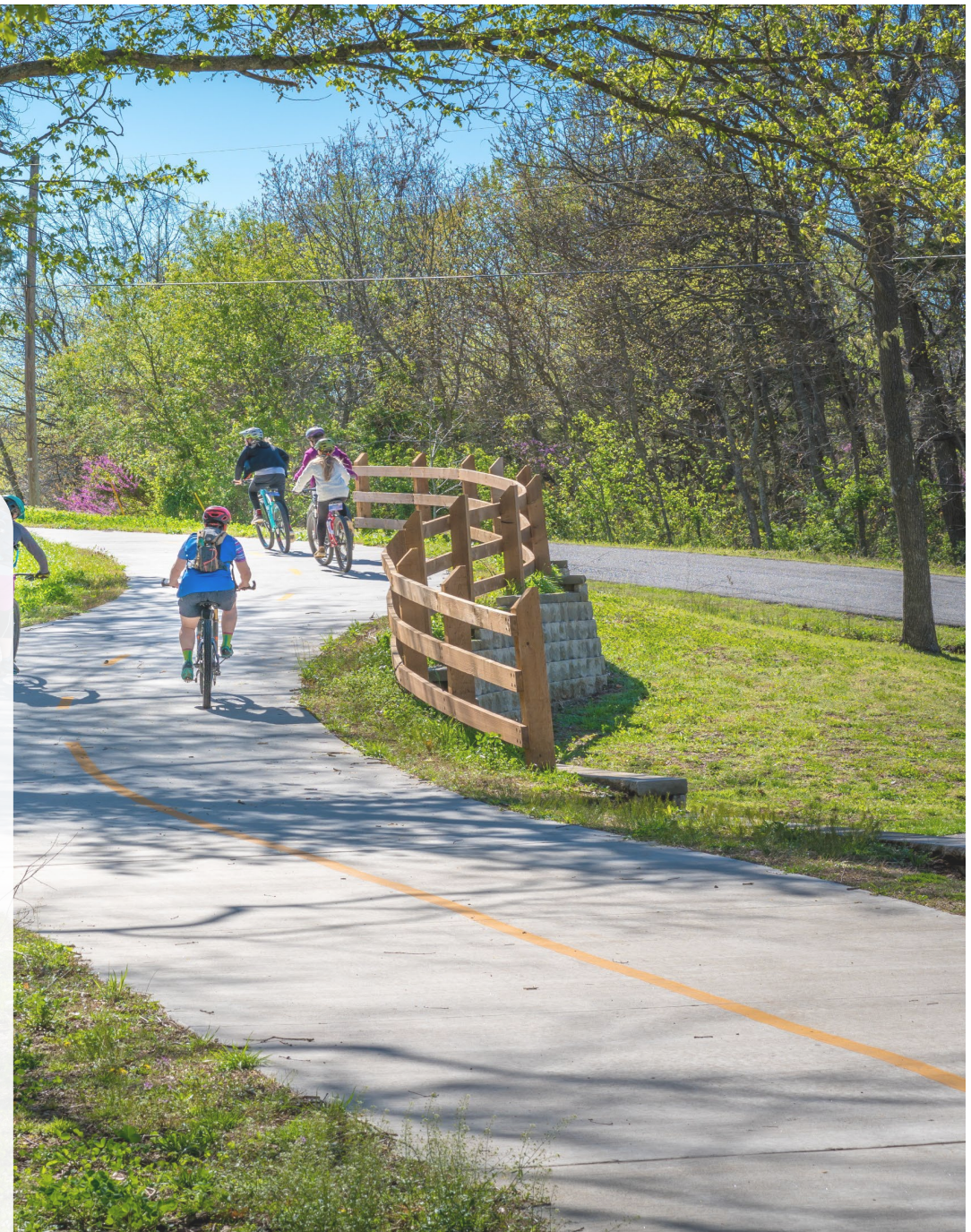

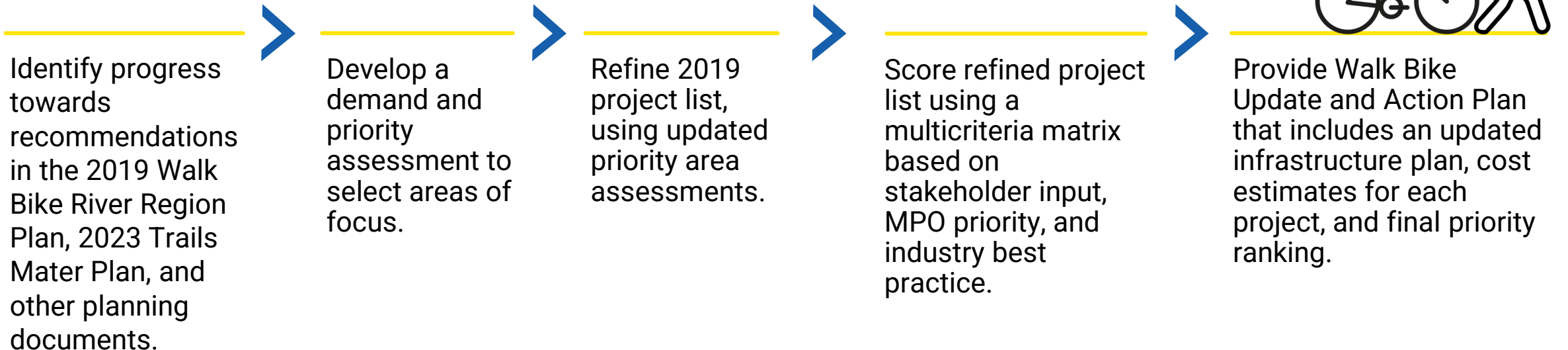

# Purpose of the Plan

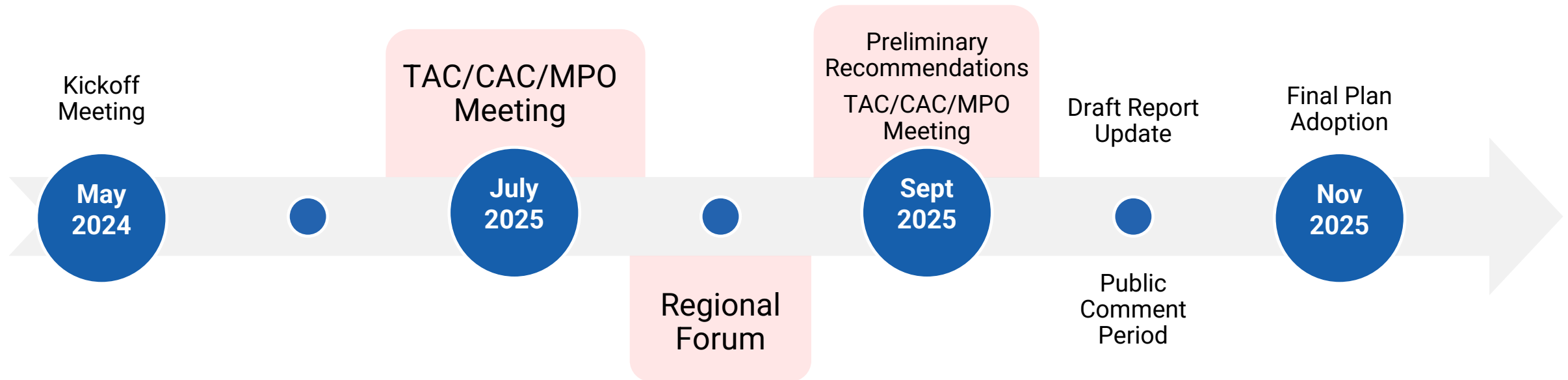

# Building on Past Plans and Progress

## 2019 Walk Bike River Region

## 2023 River Region Trails Master Plan

Envisions a connected, 100+ mile trail network in the City of Montgomery, serving as ribbons of equity, commerce, culture, community, tourism, and nature that connect people to each other and their environment.

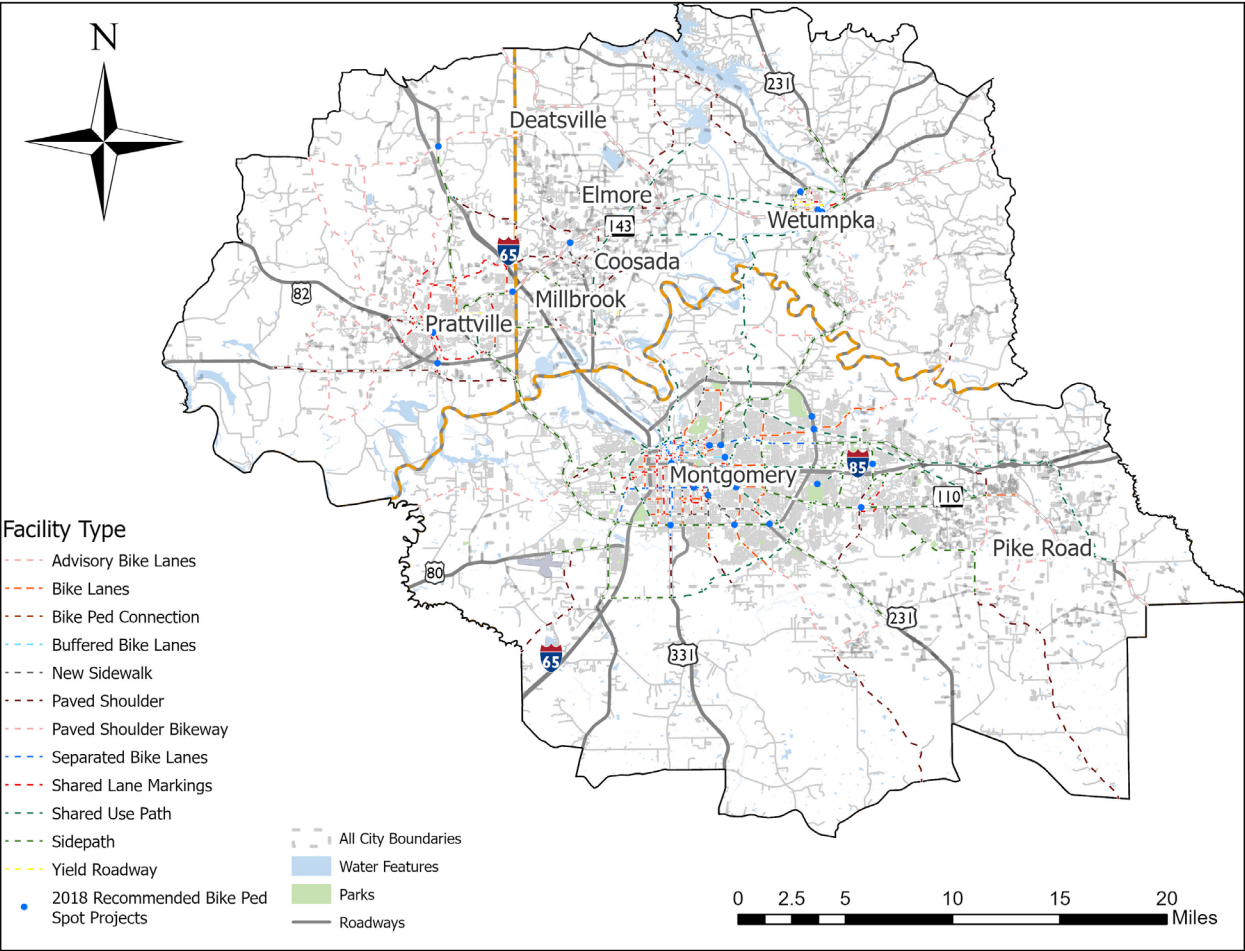
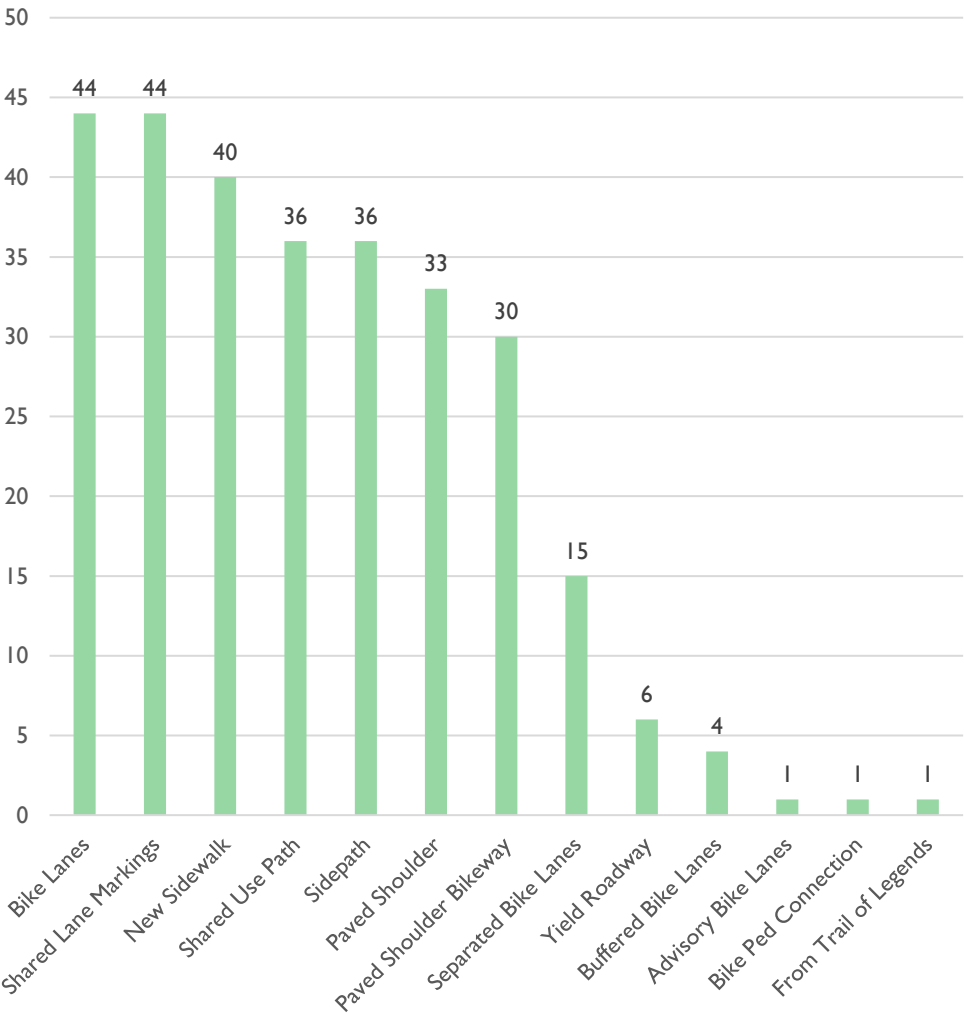
## American Rescue Plan Act funding

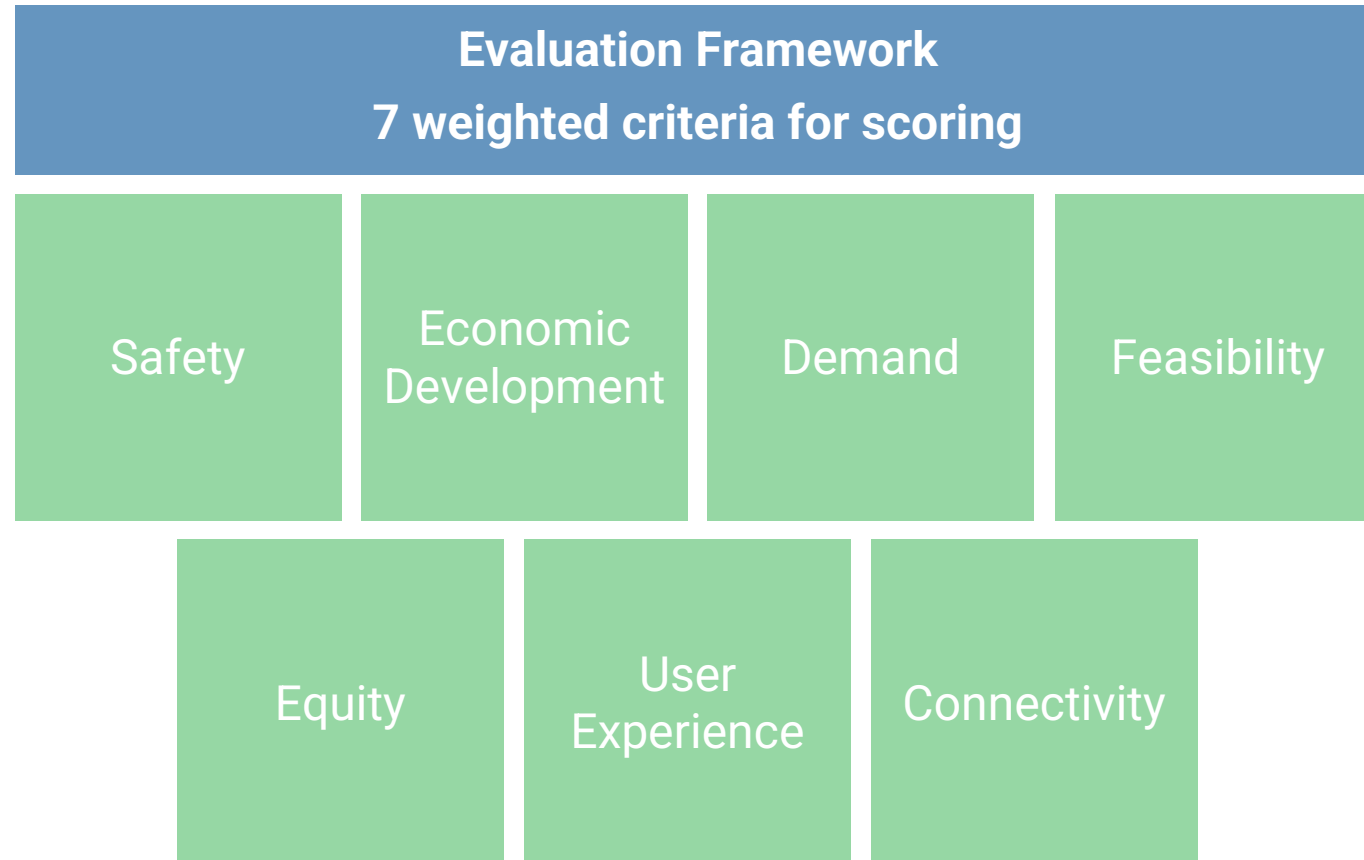

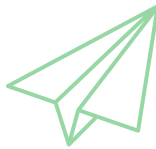

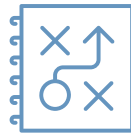
