



## Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Fiscal Year 2026 Carbon Reduction Program (CRP)

The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) receives a direct annual allocation for the Carbon Reduction Program (CRP). With the FY 2026 allocation, the Montgomery MPO Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) has a balance of **\$3,289,184.20** (Federal funds only).

Two TAP applications were received from the following municipalities: City of Montgomery and Town of Pike Road. Below is a summary of each project.
