Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Meetings Announcement

The Montgomery Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) announces that several meetings will be held to consider proposed amendments to the **Fiscal Years (FY) 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)**. The following meetings are scheduled during March 2010:

Technical Coordinating Committee—The Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) advises the MPO on the feasibility and technical aspects of proposed transportation projects. The TCC will meet on **Tuesday, March 23rd, 2010 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Citizens Advisory Committee—The Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC), the organized forum for local citizens involved in the transportation planning process, also advises the MPO. The CAC will meet **Tuesday, March 23rd, 2010 at 2:30 p.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

Metropolitan Planning Organization—The Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the policy board of local elected and appointed officials responsible for approving transportation projects and setting transportation policy in the study area portion of the tri-county area, and for adoption of the required transportation documents for the Montgomery Study Area. The MPO will meet on **Monday, March 29th, 2010 at 11:30 a.m.** at the Downtown Intermodal Transportation Facility, located at 495 Molton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104, in the Conference Room.

The proposed amendment transportation projects to be considered at each meeting for the **FY-2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)** are as follows:

- 1. Project Number IM-2-AM:** Bridge repair on I-65 from North of the Alabama River to South of Cobbs Ford Rd. The project scope is for preliminary engineering and construction. The project description is bridge repair on I-65 (Bridges 1-8, 11, and 12) including girders, caps, and bearing pads. The project length is 5.5 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$1,650,000 total dollars. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama. The preliminary engineering is \$45,000 federal funds and \$5,000 matching funds; and the construction is \$1,440,000 federal funds and \$160,000 matching funds.
- 2. Project Number IM-3-AM:** Geotechnical Investigation of all bridges at I-65/SR-8 (US-80) Interchange. The project scope is for preliminary engineering. The project length is 0.7 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$200,000 total dollars with \$180,000 in federal funds and \$20,000 in matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
- 3. Project Number TR-6-AM:** 5311 Transit Operating Assistance for FY-2010, 5311 Transit Administration Assistance for FY-2010, and 5311 Transit Operating Assistance for FY-2010 for Autauga County. The first 5311 Transit Operating Assistance for FY-2010 is \$26,518 in federal funds and \$26,518 in-kind match for a total of \$53,036. The 5311 Transit Administration Assistance for FY-2010 is \$72,451 in federal funds and \$18,113 in-kind match for a total of \$90,564. The second 5311 Transit Operating Assistance for FY-2010 is \$76,237 in federal funds and \$76,237 in-kind match for a total of \$152,474. The project sponsor is Autauga County Rural Transit.
- 4. Project Number IM-4-AM:** Sign Rehabilitation on I-65 from Conecuh County line through Butler, Lowndes, Montgomery, Elmore, and Autauga to the Chilton County line. The project scope is for preliminary engineering and construction. The project length is 92.47 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$3,220,000 total dollars. The preliminary engineering is \$108,000 federal funds and \$12,000 matching funds; and the construction is \$2,790,000 federal funds and \$310,000 matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
- 5. Project Number IM-5-AM:** Sign Rehabilitation on I-85 from I-65 through Montgomery and Macon County to the Lee County line. The project scope is for preliminary engineering and construction. The project length is 47.46 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$2,260,000 total dollars. The preliminary engineering is \$54,000 federal funds and \$6,000 matching funds; and the construction is \$2,200,000 federal funds and \$220,000 matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
- 6. Project Number IM-6-AM:** Pavement Preservation/Preventative Maintenance along with associated interstate maintenance and safety requirements. On I-65 from the North end of Crescent Lake Bridge to the Autauga County line. The project scope is for preliminary engineering and construction. The project length is 4.45 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$4,560,000 total dollars. The preliminary engineering is \$90,000 federal funds and \$10,000 matching funds; and the construction is \$4,460,000 federal funds and \$446,000 matching funds. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama.
- 7. Project Number TR-7-AM:** Section 5311 ARRA Autauga County Stimulus Operating Assistance. The total cost is \$33,737 with all dollars being federal. The project sponsor is ARRA.
- 8. Project Number M-43-AM:** Widening and Relocation of Ann Street to realign with Federal Drive. The project scope is for preliminary engineering. The project length is 0.59 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$369,897 total dollars. The project sponsor is the City of Montgomery. This project is being increased from \$334,897 total dollars to \$369,897 total dollars. This project is funded with 80 percent Federal funds and 20 percent City of Montgomery matching funds.
- 9. Project Number HHP-9-AM:** Phase five of Montgomery Outer Loop. Project location is Montgomery Outer Loop from south of State Route 110 thru I-85 interchange. Base and pave Outer Loop, service road, ramps, at State Route 110 and the I-85 interchange. The project length is 2.90 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$16,900,877. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama. This project is funded with 80 percent Federal funds and 20 percent State of Alabama matching funds.
- 10. Project Number HHP-10-AM:** Phase three of Montgomery Outer Loop. Project location is north of I-85 interchange at Montgomery Outer Loop I-85 interchange. Grade, drain, base, pave and bridge on relocation of State Route 126; widen I-85 Southbound Bridge over Millies Creek; and grade portions of ramps 1 and 2. The project length is 0.11 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$15,262,639. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama. This project is funded with 80 percent Federal funds and 20 percent State of Alabama matching funds.
- 11. Project Number HHP-11-AM:** Montgomery Outer Loop north of the I-85 Interchange. Clearing and Grubbing, Utility Relocation (East Montgomery Waterworks, Water & Sewer, Erosion Control & Temp grassing). The project length is 0.65 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$227,136. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama. This project is funded with 80 percent Federal funds and 20 percent State of Alabama matching funds.
- 12. Project Number HHP-12-AM:** Montgomery Outer Loop (SR-108) at I-85 interchange ramp bridges. Phase four, Ramp Bridges 1, 2, 3, and 4 substructure; SR-110; Millies Creek. The project length is 0.43 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$25,145,552. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama. This project is funded with 80 percent Federal funds and 20 percent State of Alabama matching funds.
- 13. Project Number NHS-16-AM:** Montgomery Outer Loop (SR-108) at I-85 interchange ramp bridges. Phase 4A, Ramp Bridges 1, 2, 3, and 4 substructure. The project length is 0.43 miles of roadway. The total cost of the project is \$25,145,552. The project sponsor is the State of Alabama. This project is funded with 80 percent Federal funds and 20 percent State of Alabama matching funds.
